National News

01 India's First Private Medical Museum

The first private medical museum in India has been opened in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala. It was established by A. Shivaman, a former artist at the Government Medical College, to preserve anatomical models and research papers.

- The Governor of Kerala is Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar.
- The Government Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram, is a premier institution in the state.

02 Sansad Ratna Awards 2026

12 MPs and 4 parliamentary committees have been honored with the Sansad Ratna Award. Introduced in 2010 on the recommendation of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, the award is presented by the Chennai-based NGO 'Prime Point Foundation'.

☑ Related Static GK

- Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam served as the 11th President of India.
- The award recognizes active participation in policy-making and parliamentary debates.

03 Tenure Extension for NCB Chief

The tenure of Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) Director General Anurag Garg has been extended by one year. He will continue in his role until July 2027.

☑ Related Static GK

- The NCB was established in 1986 under the NDPS Act, 1985.
- The headquarters of the NCB is located in New Delhi.

04 Mission Karmayogi 2.0

The central government has launched Mission Karmayogi 2.0 to modernize the training system for civil servants. It focuses heavily on AI-enabled governance and digital learning.

☑ Related Static GK

- The first phase of the Mission Karmayogi program was launched in 2020.
- The objective is to build capacity for efficient civil service delivery.

05 Union Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan's Book 'Apnapan'

The book 'Apnapan', authored by Union Minister for Agriculture Shivraj Singh Chouhan, was released in New Delhi. It documents his long political association with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

☑ Related Static GK

- Shivraj Singh Chouhan holds the record for serving as the longest-serving Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh.
- He is currently the Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare.

06 PM AJAY Portal

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment has launched the PM AJAY portal. It aims to monitor the socio-economic development of Scheduled Castes in real-time.

☑ Related Static GK

- The Union Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment is Dr. Virendra Kumar.

- The Pradhan Mantri Anusuchit Jaati Abhyuday Yojana (PM AJAY) was initiated in 2021-22.

07 BHAVYA Scheme

The government has appointed the National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC) as the nodal agency for the BHAVYA scheme, which has a budget of ₹33,660 crore. It aims to build 100 world-class industrial parks.

☑ Related Static GK

- The scheme is set to run from the fiscal year 2026-27 to 2031-32.
- The focus is on 'Plug and Play' infrastructure for manufacturing.

08 India's First Geothermal Power Project

India's first geothermal power project is being established in the Puga Valley of Ladakh by ONGC.

☑ Related Static GK

- ONGC was established in 1956 and is headquartered in New Delhi.
- Geothermal energy harnesses heat from the Earth's interior for power generation.

International News

09 International Missing Children's Day

Observed globally on 25 May, this day highlights efforts to prevent child disappearance.

☑ Related Static GK

- 25 May is also celebrated as 'Africa Day', commemorating the founding of the African Union in 1963.

10 National AI and Digital Water Summit

The first 'National AI and Digital Water Summit' was held in Bengaluru. It was organized by the Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board.

☑ Related Static GK

- The Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board was established in 1964.
- The summit focused on AI-based water management and digital twins.
