## Sports News

### 01 RCB's Consecutive IPL Win

Royal Challengers Bengaluru (RCB) secured their second consecutive IPL trophy in 2026 after defeating the Gujarat Titans. The final, held at the Narendra Modi Stadium, saw a dominant performance by the RCB squad.

### 03 India's 100th Ramsar Site

Marking a significant milestone in environmental conservation, the 'Surha Tal' within the Jayaprakash Narayan Bird Sanctuary in Uttar Pradesh has been declared India's 100th Ramsar site.

- The Ramsar Convention was established specifically for the conservation of wetlands.
- The convention became effective in 1975.

### 04 Government Initiatives

Union Agriculture Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has launched the 'Khet Bachao Abhiyan' in Madhya Pradesh. Meanwhile, in Assam, 'Mission Sneh Jori' has been introduced to boost Muga silk production, and development has begun in Chumar village, Ladakh, to establish it as India's first model border village.
