Political Shift in Bihar: Samrat Choudhary Becomes 24th CM

After a period of intense political maneuvering, Bihar has a new leadership. Following the resignation of Nitish Kumar, **Samrat Choudhary** has taken the mantle as the **24th Chief Minister** of the state.

This marks a historic milestone as he is the first leader from the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) to hold the Chief Ministerial post in Bihar. Governor **Syed Ata Hasnain** administered the oath of office at the Raj Bhavan ceremony.

Joining the new cabinet, JDU's **Vijay Kumar Chaudhary** and **Bijendra Prasad Yadav** have been sworn in as Deputy Chief Ministers. Notably, this transition ends a long era for Nitish Kumar, who served as CM a record **10 times** between 2000 and 2026.

The prestigious Wisden Cricketers' Almanack has unveiled its list of top performers for **2026**, with Indian cricketers featuring prominently across categories.

India's **Deepti Sharma** has been honored as the Leading Women's Cricketer in the World. In the men's segment, Australia's **Mitchell Starc** claimed the top spot, while India's rising star **Abhishek Sharma** was named the Leading T20 Cricketer.

The coveted 'Five Cricketers of the Year' list is dominated by India, featuring **Shubman Gill**, **Ravindra Jadeja**, **Rishabh Pant**, and **Mohammed Siraj**. England's Haseeb Hameed is the only non-Indian player to make this year's list.

Medical Breakthrough: Nagaland's Herbal Remedy for Cancer

Indian researchers have reported a significant breakthrough in oncology. A traditional herbal remedy used by the **Konyak tribe** of Nagaland has been found to contain potent anti-cancer properties.

The discovery is the result of a collaborative study conducted by Nagaland University, Berhampur University, and Saveetha Medical College. The Konyaks are renowned as a warrior tribe, and their culture is highlighted by the famous **Aolang Monyu** festival.

India Surpasses Japan to Become World's 4th Largest Economy

The IMF's **April 2026** World Economic Outlook report brings a major milestone for the Indian economy. India has officially overtaken Japan to become the **fourth largest economy** in the world.

The United States, China, and Germany continue to hold the top three positions. With a nominal GDP reaching **4.3 trillion USD**, India is on a steady upward trajectory. Furthermore, the IMF projects a GDP growth rate of **6.5 percent** for the 2026 fiscal year.

To combat the growing water crisis in Ladakh, the government has introduced **Project Him Sarovar**. This initiative focuses on building **50 small reservoirs** across the Leh and Kargil districts to store glacial meltwater.

In the industrial sector, an **India-Taiwan Industrial Park** is being developed in Gujarat's Sanand and Dholera regions with technical aid from Taiwan. Additionally, to support the entrepreneurial ecosystem, the **Startup India Fund of Funds 2.0** has been officially launched.
